PSD has extended its partnership with PRIA (Participatory Research in Asia) and MFF (Martha Farrell Foundation) for Kadam Badhate Chalo (KBC) 3.0, which will be launched with new cohorts of youth leaders in 7 new locations in various parts of the country.



As part of its support for KBC, PSD utilizes sports-based interventions to facilitate interaction between girls and boys, subtly question gender stereotypes, build leadership capability, challenge perceptions of violence against girls and women and equip youth with sporting values such as equality, teamwork and respect.
